Goods-Producing

Agriculture (0.8% GDP)

> NAICS 11. Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing and Hunting

- Agriculture
 - o Fruits (orchards), vegetables, cattle, pigs other animal products.
 - o Ex: Chiquita Brands and Prairie Farms
- Forestry
 - o Timber tract operations, forest nurseries, logging.
 - o Ex: North Fork Timber Company and Potlatchdeltic Corporation
- Fishing
 - Ex: Fishing Company of Alaska Inc and Coastal Shellfish LLC
- Hunting
 - o Ex: California Wildlife Center and Wildlife Management Institute

Mining and Construction (5.5% GDP)

NAICS 21. Mining, Quarrying, and Oil Extraction (1.4% GDP)

- o Oil and gas extraction, coal/metal mining, quarrying.
- Ex: Halliburton Company and Andeavor LLC

> NAICS 23. Construction (4.1% GDP)

- Building construction, highway/street/bridge construction, painters, drywall/insulation contractors, electricians, plumbers, water and gas pipeline construction.
- o Ex: DR Horton Inc and Emcor Group Inc

Manufacturing: NAICS 31-33 (10.7% GDP)

> NAICS 33, 321, 327. Durable (6.0% GDP)

- Motor vehicles, aircrafts, furniture, metal production, hand tools, hardware, industrial machinery, computers, semiconductors, batteries, household appliances.
- o Ex: Ford Motor Company and Intel Corporation

> NAICS 31, 322-326. Nondurable (4.7% GDP)

 Petroleum and coal products, chemical production, pharmaceuticals and medicine, paint, plastics and rubber, processed food and beverages, fabric, apparel, footwear, paper products. Ex: Johnson & Johnson and Exxon Mobil Corporation

Service-Producing Industries

Trade, Transportation, and Utilities (18.7% GDP)

> NAICS 44-45. Retail Trade (6.0% GDP)

- Car dealers, grocery stores, department stores, gas stations, florists, office supply stores.
- Ex: Home Depot Inc and Walmart Inc

> NAICS 42. Wholesale Trade (6.2% GDP)

- Construction and Mining Equipment, paper products, farm products, chemical and petroleum wholesalers.
- o Ex: Sysco Corporation and McKesson Corporation

> NAICS 48-49. Transportation and Warehousing (3.0% GDP)

- Airlines, rail services, metro systems, postal service, taxis, general/refrigerated warehousing and storage.
- Ex: Delta Air Lines Inc, United Parcel Service Inc, and Norfolk Southern Railway Co

NAICS 22. Utilities (1.6% GDP)

- Power generation/transmission/distribution, natural gas distribution, water and sewage.
- o Ex: Duke Energy Corporation and Los Angeles Dept Wtr & Pwr

Information: NAICS 51 (5.6% GDP)

- Computing infrastructure, Data Processing, web hosting, libraries, web search portals, motion Pictures, newspapers and books, software publishers, radio/tv broadcasting, telecommunications.
- o Ex: AT&T Inc, Fiserv Inc, and Linkedin Corporation

Finance Activities (21.0% GDP)

> NAICS 52. Finance and Insurance (8.4% GDP)

- Banks/credit unions, portfolio management, credit card issuing, loan brokers, financial transactions processing, insurance carriers/agencies, Pension funds, health and welfare funds.
- Ex: Berkshire Hathaway Inc, Unitedhealth Group Inc, and American Express Company

> NAICS 53. Real Estate and Rental and Leasing (12.6% GDP)

- Real estate agents/brokers, car rental agencies, rental centers, (non)residential property managers, lessors (landlords) of real estate.
- o Ex: Opendoor Technologies Inc and Hertz Global Holdings Inc

Professional Business Services (13.0% GDP)

> NAICS 54. Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services (7.9% GDP)

- Research and development (Biotech, hard sciences, social sciences), legal services (lawyers, notaries, etc.), accounting, architectural and engineering services, interior/graphic design, consulting services, advertising, PR, veterinarians.
- Ex: Alphabet Inc, H & R Block Inc, and Omnicom Group Inc

> NAICS 55. Management of Companies and Enterprises (1.9% GDP)

- Offices of Bank Holding Companies, corporate/subsidiary/regional managing offices.
- Ex: Allied Universal Topco LLC and Wilmington Trust Corporation

NAICS 56. Administrative, Support and Waste Management and Remediation Services (3.2% GDP)

- Office admin services, travel agents, security guards, armored cars, janitorial services, waste collection and related services.
- Ex: Waste Management Inc and Uber Technologies Inc

Education and Health Services (8.6% GDP)

> NAICS 61. Education services (1.2% GDP)

- o Unis, k-12, tech/trade schools, and education support services
- o Ex: Johns Hopkins University and North Crlna Cmmnty Clg Sys Off

> NAICS 62. Health care and social assistance (7.4% GDP)

- Dentists, Hospitals, nursing care facilities, childcare services
- o Ex: Kaiser Foundation Hlth Plan Inc and Brookdale Senior Living Inc

Leisure and Hospitality (3.9% GDP)

➤ NAICS 71. Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation (0.9% GDP)

- Museums, amusement parks, gambling, performing arts, artists, writers.
- Ex: Walt Disney Company, Carolina Panthers, and Caesars Holdings Inc

➤ NAICS 72. Accommodation and Food Services (2.9% GDP)

- o Restaurants, Bars, hotels, special food caterers
- Ex: Starbucks Corporation and Aramark

Other Services: NAICS 81 (2.0% GDP)

- Repair and maintenance, barber shops, beauty salons, religious orgs, drycleaning/laundry services, professional/social/civic/political organizations, funeral homes and cemeteries
- o Ex: Valvoline Inc and Salvation Army National Corp

Government: NAICS 92 (12.1% GDP)

- Local, State, Federal
 - Executive/legislative offices/bodies, judicial courts, police, firefighters, space research and technology, national security.
 - Ex: Juvenile Justice Texas Dept, Marine Corps Forces Reserve US, and Nasa/Lyndon B Jhnson Space Ctr
